In 1909 the name WINNIPEG SQUASH RACQUET CLUB came into existence. From this date a committee of our most progressive business and professional gentlemen set themselves to the task of creating the first Squash Racquet Club.

The first building was located at 79 Donald Street just south of Broadway. The early records of the Club make fascinating reading for any Winnipeg historian as the names mentioned read like a “WHO’S WHO” of the young city’s business world.

The original Club building finally yielded to progress in 1958 when it was sold to a financial institution for part of its Canadian head office grounds. From this sale grew the fine new Winnipeg Squash Racquet Club on the present site at 275 Stradbrook Avenue, with a doubles and four single International Courts.

Since then the Winnipeg Squash Racquet Club has endeavored to continue to upgrade its facilities and provide a modern environment for our membership.

The Club is arguably one of the finest sport and recreation facilities of its kind in Canada providing one of the venues for squash, fitness, business and social networking.

We take pride in offering elite squash programs, National and International tournaments, and the development of a very active junior program.

The Winnipeg Squash Racquet Club remains committed to its mission – to provide the best squash, health and social facilities for the enjoyment and benefit of its members.

The Club also has a fully equipped Fitness Facility complete with free weights, stationary and cardiovascular equipment.
- **SQUASH PRO** – The WSRC is pleased to have David Glass as our Club Pro. David has represented Canada and Manitoba in competitive squash with distinction. He has been a ten time Manitoba Squash Champion and is currently ranked #1 in Manitoba.
- **TOURNAMENTS** - The WSRC hosts a number of tournaments throughout the year including the Manitoba Open. The Manitoba Opens attracts players from around the world.

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Membership **Categories**

Shareholder Status Memberships:

Regular Membership:

A person 30 years of age or older.

Junior Executive Membership:

Any person, at least 21 years of age and under 30 years of age is qualified for a membership in the Club at a reduced rate. The month following the members 30th birthday, the membership and fee is automatically changed to that of a Regular Member.

Non-Resident Member:

A Regular Member residing 200 km outside the City of Winnipeg who does not pay monthly dues but is assessed an annual fee.

Corporate Member:

Three or more members from the same company, with no age requirements. Required sponsorship/advertising purchase of \$1500.00 annually.

Non-Shareholder Status Memberships:

Early Professional Membership:

An individual who has completed their undergraduate degree or equivalent programs and are currently involved in a residency, internship, or articling program. Maximum of three years of registration in this category.

Student Member - Senior:

An individual 19 years or older, enrolled as a full-time student is assessed an annual fee.

Student Member – Junior:

An individual between the age of 15 and 18 years, enrolled as a full-time student is assessed an annual fee. Students are restricted in their use of the Club as outlined in the Student Member Package.

Honorary Membership:

Conferred on a member of the Club in recognition of many years of dedicated service and outstanding contribution to the objectives of the Club. Included as well are the Premier of Manitoba, the Mayor of Winnipeg and all Honorary Consuls of Manitoba.

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Membership Dues and Fees

All new Shareholder Memberships are required to purchase a Winnipeg Squash Racquet Club refundable share and pay an entrance fee prior to joining.

***Building Assessment Fee applies to new Regular and Junior Executive members only. The fee is charged at \$10.00 per month or \$120.00 annually over a 5-year period up to a maximum of \$600.00.

OTHER

Gratuities: \$50.00 (plus GST) is charged semi-annually to Regular, Junior Executive and Senior Members in May and November.

Minimum House Charge: The minimum food assessment for Regular, Senior and Junior Executive members will be charged at \$90.00 (plus GST) every quarter with no carry-overs. The quarters end April, July, October and January. All charges for food (excluding beverages and taxes) **consumed** in the Club will be credited towards the minimum amount and the remaining to be used stated on the monthly account statement.

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Student Membership

1. Eligibility

Early Professional Member, an individual who has completed their undergrad or equivalent program and is currently involved in a residency, internship or articling program. Please note that there is a 3 year membership maximum before being required to join as a shareholder.

Senior Student Member, an individual 19 years or older and enrolled as a full-time student.

Junior Student Member, an individual between the ages of 15 and 18 years and enrolled as a full-time student.

i. Students enrolled in post-secondary education, full-time courses at University or College will be admitted as student members at the sole discretion of the Board of Directors of the Club.

2. Hours of Play

Student Members have full use of the facility from 5:00 a.m. till 12:00 a.m.

3. Locker Rental

Individual lockers for students or non-resident members can be purchased for \$25/month

***note that shareholders will be given first priority for lockers. In the event of a locker shortage, the Club reserves the right to reacquire student locker rentals by providing 30 days notice.*

4. Guest Privileges

Junior and Senior student members shall not be permitted to bring guests into the Club without permission from the General Manager or Club Pro. Please note that Early Professionals have the same privileges as Shareholder members.

5. Squash Lessons

Students may book squash lessons with the Club Pro.

8. Charging Privileges

Allowed only when either a **pre-authorized debit form** or Credit Card information is completed or student account is linked to a parent account.
